










2019 - Student per Teacher FTE Comparison








The chart below shows the 2019 average salaries for Student Support Services positions which include: guidance counselors, nurses, occupational and physical therapists, psychologists and social workers.






2019 - Elementary Principal Salary






#### 2019 - Secondary Principal Salary
